As for 2015, we forgot it in the wooden barrels for too long - I mean, Silene in wood? - what, with our minds taken by the sadness for the frost in the vineyard, the fire in the olive groves and by the hundreds of other problems that 2017 bestowed upon us.

Dare not to throw away, dare to make a statement, dare to discover and be surprised. The tale without veils - and face masks - of a lost wine and a found wine.
